21. SCRUTINY – SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Motorkhana - Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport are to be worn in ALL specials. Apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. All cars must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Cars must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. A current and valid CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Competition Licence or superior, and Club Membership Card of a NSW or ACT CAMS-Affiliated Car Club and vehicle Log Book (if issued) must be presented at document check. Any camera or video recording device mounted in or on a competition vehicle must be approved by the Chief Scrutineer.

22. CLASSES:

Motorkhana Classes:

- Class A Production Vehicles Wheelbase up to 2150mm
- Class B Production Vehicles Wheelbase 2151 to 2390mm
- Class C Production Vehicles Wheelbase 2391 to 2574mm
- Class D Production Vehicles Wheelbase 2575mm and over.
- Class F Front Wheel Drive Specials
- Class G Rear Wheel Drive Specials
- Class H Production Vehicle Based Specials

Non production 4WS (4 Wheel Steering) and 4wd vehicles are not permitted

Motorkhana Categories:

(Nomination in a category does not preclude a driver for competing for class awards)

- Category J Juniors
- Category LP Ladies in Production Vehicles
- Category LS Ladies in Specials

23. RESULTS PRIZES AND TROPHIES

1st Outright, 1st in each Class (minimum 3 entries in Class), 1st in each Category (minimum 3 entries in Category). Other awards at the Director's discretion. All awards are mutually exclusive. Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, inclusive of penalties. Timing shall be to 0.01 of a second.

24. The CAMS permit will be displayed at the start of the event.

25. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

26. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt by the Event Secretary. Competition numbers shall be allocated at the discretion of the Clerk of Course. Upon receipt of entries the organisers will allocate competition numbers by class. Eg: A1 to A10, B1 to B10 etc. This will assist in ensuring equal conditions amongst classes.

27. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to parent/guardian.

28. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement). Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au

29. Start and Finish procedures shall be in accordance with Article 13 of the National Motorkhana Code. Running order shall be at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

30. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

31. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

32. Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

33. Food and drinks will be available to purchase at the venue.

34. Toilet facilities are available near the TAFE library, approx. 150m from Motorkhana area.

35. Fuel is not available at the venue, the closest service station is on the corner of Grady St and Quakers Hill Parkway, 5 minute drive.
