

Jugiong 2021 COVID-19 Event Plan

General Information

All necessary documents required for this event will be available on the Renault Car Club of Australia website: www.rcca.org.au. Documents are to be sent to: event.secretary@rcca.org.au.

All competitors / officials are strongly encouraged to utilise the COVID-19 phone app in line with Motorsport Australia and government recommendations.

Entries and Documentation

All entries should be completed prior to the event using the entry form available on the RCCA website. Fees can be paid by bank transfer or cheque prior to close of entries.

If a person wishes to enter on the day, they MUST complete the entry form, scan it and email it, together with scrutineering forms, to the organisers. Entry fee must be paid by direct deposit or credit card. Cash/cheque payments will not be accepted on the day.

Licence / log book checks will be carried out electronically prior to the event. Competitors with their MA licences on their phone may display this to Event Officials prior to the start of the event if unable to provide an image.

Scrutineering

SCRUTINEERING WILL NOT BE PERFORMED (as per Motorsport Australia requirements). In order for an entry to be accepted, each entrant must complete and send to organisers a *Self-Scrutiny Checklist: Autotest* and a *Self-Scrutiny: Statement of Vehicle Compliance* relating to the suitability of their vehicle to compete. These forms will be available from the RCCA website.

Entrants must clearly display their competition numbers on both sides of the vehicle. Numbers will be provided prior to the event.

Passengers

Passengers will be permitted subject to the following conditions:

- a. ALL passengers MUST complete and submit electronically to the organisers the appropriate *Passenger Ride Entry Form* prior to the event. This form will be available on the RCCA website.
- b. A junior being supervised by a parent /guardian that lives in the same household;
- c. Another member of the same house may be a passenger, without having to 'Wear a mask and gloves;
- d. Where a passenger is not from the same household, then both the passenger and driver must wear MASKS.

COVID-19 Information

A register of attendance will be maintained for all Competitors / Officials in attendance at the event. The event is outdoors on private property permitting up to 100 spectators (7 Dec 2020 NSW Govt advice).

Where there are multiple drivers in a vehicle, the drivers are responsible for the COVID-19 cleaning of the vehicle and the supply of cleaning materials.

Supplies of hand sanitiser will be available at the Admin Area desk and at each test.

Social distancing rules will apply based on 1 person for every 2 square metres (as per NSW government requirements, 7 Dec 2020).

Social distancing signage will be displayed appropriately.

During the event competitors / officials / spectators MUST adhere to 'SOCIAL DISTANCING' requirements of 1.5 metres in line with government requirements.

If not competing competitors MUST maintain social distancing on the competition area.

Competitors will NOT be supplied with individual time cards.

Additional notes

Following the first round of tests a sufficient time interval will be provided to allow competitors to return to the Jugiong Hall if required.
