Documentation

For entries to be accepted, all documentation must be completed prior to Close of Entries.

After reading the **Supp Regs**, please complete the **Entry Form** and email to the above address.

Please provide a scan or photo of your Club membership card and MA licence both of which are valid for the event date. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

Payment of the entry fee is by direct deposit or cheque prior to Close of Entries.

Scrutineering

As per Motorsport Australia requirements, scrutineering will be done by competitors. The required forms (available on our website) must be completed and emailed before close of entries.

Passengers

Everyone who intends to be a passenger in a vehicle **MUST** complete the **Passenger Ride Entry Form** and forward it to the organisers before Close of Entries. No applications will be accepted on the day.

Drivers Briefing

A Drivers Briefing will be made available to competitors after Close of Entries. You will be required to indicate by the specified method that you have read this information.

Car Numbers

Car numbers will be provided to competitors after Close of Entries. Competitors are responsible for displaying these numbers clearly on both sides of the vehicle.

COVID-19 Procedures

The following is based on the most recently available NSW Government advice and Motorsport Australia restrictions.

A register of officials and competitors will be made for contact tracing purposes.

Social distancing – please remain 1.5 metres apart at all times. If this is not possible, please wear a mask.

Hand sanitizer will be available at the event.

Competitor timing cards will not be provided.

Spectators are to stay outside the event area, remaining 1.5 metres apart.
