- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter-signed/consented to by a parent/guardian.

20. SCRUTINY:
A self-scrutiny vehicle check must be performed by the competitor and driver using a Self-Scrutiny Checklist – Auto Test. The Self-Scrutiny Checklist form and the Event Entry Self-Scrutiny Statement of Vehicle Compliance (TSP03EE) scrutineering declaration must be completed, signed and emailed to the Event Secretary prior to the event.
If, for some reason, this is not possible, contact the Event Secretary via email to discuss alternatives.
Competition numbers shall be allocated at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
21. SCRUTINY – SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS
Motorkhana – Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the current Motorsport Australia Manual are to be worn in ALL specials. Apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current Motorsport Australia Manual. Cars must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
Any camera or video recording device mounted in or on a competition vehicle must be approved by the Chief Scrutineer.
22. LICENCES
Competitors must have a current and valid Speed/Speed Junior Competition Licence or superior and Club Membership Card of a Motorsport Australia-Affiliated Car Club.
A valid Club membership card and a valid Motorsport Australia Speed/Speed Junior licence for this event must be presented at Document Check. This can be done electronically or in person.
Drivers must present vehicle Log Books (if issued) for stamping by the Chief Scrutineer.
23. CLASSES:
Motorkhana Classes:
Class A Production 2WD Vehicles Wheelbase up to 2150mm
Class B Production 2WD Vehicles Wheelbase 2151 to 2390mm
Class C Production 2WD Vehicles Wheelbase 2391 to 2574mm
Class D Production 2WD Vehicles Wheelbase 2575mm and over.
Class F Front Wheel Drive Specials
Class G Rear Wheel Drive Specials
Class H Production Vehicle Based Specials
Non-production 4WS (4 Wheel Steering) and 4WD vehicles are not permitted
Note: Group 4H Regulations prohibit 4WD in specials

Category J Juniors
Category LP Ladies in Production Vehicles
Category LS Ladies in Specials
24. RESULTS, PRIZES AND TROPHIES
1st Outright, 1st in each Class (minimum 3 entries in Class), 1st in each Category (minimum 3 entries in Category). Other awards at the Director's discretion. ALL AWARDS ARE MUTUALLY EXCLUSIVE.
A competitor's fastest time (including penalties) on each test shall count towards their overall total. Event results shall be determined by the lowest total of competitors' times on all tests.
25. CONDUCT OF EVENT:
The Motorsport Australia permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
Start and Finish procedures shall be in accordance with National Motorkhana Standing Regulations.
Running order shall be at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
Timing shall be to 0.01 second.

All Officials shall be deemed to be Judges of Fact in accordance with National Motorkhana Standing Regulations and the NCR.

Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with the NCR of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

26. PASSENGERS:

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the MA MSPRA Policy.

27. PROTESTS:

Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

28. FACILITIES

The event will not be catered, but drinks will be available to purchase at the venue.

Toilet facilities are available near the TAFE library.

Fuel is not available at the venue. The closest service station is on the corner of Grady St and Quakers Hill Parkway – a five-minute drive.

29. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.
