The Event will be conducted under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Motorkhana Standing Regulations, the NSW Motorkhana Addendum, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations which may be issued. The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at <u>www.motorsport.org.au</u> Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. 19. SCRUTINY:

A self-scrutiny vehicle check must be performed by the competitor and driver using a Self-Scrutiny Checklist – Auto Test. The Self-Scrutiny Checklist form <u>and</u> the Event Entry Self-Scrutiny Statement of Vehicle Compliance declaration must be completed, signed and emailed to the Event Secretary prior to the event.

If, for some reason, this is not possible, contact the Event Secretary via email to discuss alternatives.

Competition numbers shall be allocated at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

21. SCRUTINY - SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Motorkhana – Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual are to be worn in ALL specials. Apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the Motorsport Australia Manual. Cars must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

NOTE: Electric vehicles (EVs) will not be permitted to be entered at this event due to lack of officials' specific safety training and EV-specific safety equipment.

Any camera or video recording device mounted in or on a competition vehicle must be approved by the Chief Scrutineer.

21. LICENCES

Competitors must have a current and valid Speed/Speed Junior Competition Licence or superior and Club Membership Card of a Motorsport Australia-Affiliated Car Club.

A valid Club membership card and a valid Motorsport Australia Speed/Speed Junior licence for this event must be presented at Document Check. This can be done electronically or in person.

Drivers must present vehicle Log Books (if issued) for stamping by the Chief Scrutineer.

23. CLASSES:

Motorkhana Classes:

Class A Production 2WD Vehicles Wheelbase up to 2150mm

Class B Production 2WD Vehicles Wheelbase 2151 to 2390mm

Class C Production 2WD Vehicles Wheelbase 2391 to 2574mm

Class D Production 2WD Vehicles Wheelbase 2575mm and over.

Class E 4WD vehicles (which must be driven in the four-wheel drive mode throughout the competition)

Class F Front Wheel Drive Specials

Class G Rear Wheel Drive Specials

Class H Production Vehicle Based Specials

Non-production 4WS (4 Wheel Steering) and 4WD vehicles are not permitted

Note: Group 4H Regulations prohibit 4WD in specials

(Nomination in a category does not preclude a driver from competing for class awards) Category J Juniors Category LP Ladies in Production Vehicles

23. RESULTS, PRIZES AND TROPHIES

1st Outright, 1st in each Class (minimum 3 entries in Class), 1st in each Category (minimum 3 entries in Category). Other awards at the Director's discretion.

A competitor's fastest time (including penalties) on each test shall count towards their overall total. Event results shall be determined by the lowest total of competitors' times on all tests.

ALL AWARDS ARE MUTUALLY EXCLUSIVE and will be allocated in the following order:

Outright, Class, Category.

24. CONDUCT OF EVENT:

The Motorsport Australia permit will be displayed at the start of the Event.

Start and Finish procedures shall be in accordance with Motorkhana Standing Regulations.

Running order shall be at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Timing shall be to 0.01 second.

All Officials shall be deemed to be Judges of Fact in accordance with National Motorkhana Standing Regulations and the NCR.

The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.

25. PASSENGERS:

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the MA MSPRA Policy.

26. PROTESTS:

Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

27. FACILITIES

The event will not be catered, but drinks will be available to purchase at the venue.

Toilet facilities are available in the BREED building across the road from the venue.

Fuel is not available at the venue. The closest service station is on the corner of Grady St and Quakers Hill Parkway – a five-minute drive from the venue.

28. DAMAGE TO EQUIPMENT

The organisers reserve the right to recover the cost of any equipment damaged (including shipping charges) from anyone who damages equipment during the course of the event, whether this be deliberate or accidental.

29. Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia. Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
